





#### Text piece 1

This superhero comes from another planet but was adopted by farmers Jonathan and Martha Kent. They named him Clark Kent. He has many superhuman abilities, such as super strength and flight, and he uses these abilities to fight crime. To protect his human identity, he wears a special suit with a red cape and a large 'S' on his chest.

#### Text piece 2

This superhero was created by the Greek Gods. As well as beauty and wisdom, she possesses superhuman strength and superhuman intelligence. She is able to sense the emotions and feelings of others and communicate with animals. She can also communicate through her thoughts (telepathically). She is able to heal some injuries and has superhuman hearing. Her weapon is a golden rope called the 'Lasso of Truth', which disables a person's ability to tell a lie. She also has 'Bracelets of Submission', which deflect bullets.

#### Text piece 3

This superhero, also known as Peter Parker, begins life as an orphan who lives with his aunt and uncle. His life is changed when he is bitten by a spider and begins to show superhuman powers. He has spider-like qualities, like strength, speed, the ability to cling to surfaces, the ability to spin webs and superfast reaction times. He works hard to fight crime and protect the people of New York City.
